

Monthly Meeting with the DMCs on 30.5.11 – Review of RSBY work

A presentation was made by the Manager, RSBY on the progress of current enrolment and utilization of services by the beneficiaries.

Actionable points:

1. To improve enrolment conversion rate in district Hoshiarpur from current rate of 56% to minimum of 70% or more.

“All SMOs to be requested to extend the help of ASHAs to the fullest. Every SMO needs to ensure and monitor distribution of slips through ASHA in their respective blocks”

2. Civil Surgeons to be directed to release incentive of Rs. 20 /- to the ASHAs for enrolment.

3. Proposal for giving incentive to Anganwaries for Urban Areas to be submitted for provision of budget.

(Action by Manager RSBY)

4. In District Moga, proper attention was not paid by the hospital authorities/pharmacist and despite good attendance of card holders, all efforts went in vain. DMC Moga has forwarded a copy of the explanation letter issued to the Pharmacist to PHSC as well.

(Show cause to be issued to SMO-CH, Moga & the Pharmacist)

5. Focus on Govt. Hospitals of District Tarn Taran to start providing health services to RSBY card holders. The performance of Govt. Hospitals has been Zero as regard to claim registry since past one year. In comparison to this, private hospitals have been registering claims in good numbers. MD, PHSC asked the DMC Tarn Taran to conduct health camps and take other measures to improve the position.

(Action by DMC Tarn Taran)

6. **Data revision in case of 10 Districts which are due for Renewal:** Ropar DMC brought out that existing data has discrepancies like repetition and requested to issue directions for necessary revision. Similarly in other district, the DMCs were requested to update existing data wherever necessary.

(A D.O. to be written to DCs of Ropar, Muktsar, Ferozepur, Patiala, Moga, Nawan Shahar, Faridkot etc from the desk of MD, PHSC)

7. **Training for Hospitals** – Claim registry of District Mohali was not up to desired level :

It was pointed out that the SMOs are not made aware of the procedure and provisions of the scheme. They still hesitate in coming forward for RSBY patients as they are not sure of the claim procedure. Instance of CHC Kurali and Derrabassi was quoted. MD, PHSC directed to hold a review of the work of this district separately.
